Nik Baeyens is a Belgian designer and artist who graduated as Master of Integral Product Development in Antwerp. As a freelancer, he designs products for various brands in different fields, selling them successfully around Europe. In his designs, he initiates stories to trigger people's feelings, catching their attention to offer new experiences. He combines fairy tales, characters, logo's & images of popular culture to intuitively create new stories. Screen printing and hand-painting are his favored techniques. In a brief way, Nik Baeyens is looking for interaction between the art and the viewer to obtain an "Awareness of Life!".



Joël Roth is an illustrator from St.Gallen (CH). He works as a freelance illustrator. His graphic education has shaped him from an early age: clear lines and abstracted forms characterize his work. He can spend hours refining form and composition until every stroke is precise, resulting in a harmonious overall image. His proximity to nature and the mountains inspires his subjects, which he enjoys screen printing onto posters or shirts.



Thomas Heinz is a German-born Designer, Illustrator, and animator. In his career, he has studied carpentry, and communication design at the University of Würzburg attended an art school in Canberra Australia and received a degree from the Academy of Media Arts in Cologne Germany. He is the Co-founder of Studio Flachbild alongside his partners Alexander Lorenz and Gido Martis in Cologne.



Marc David Spengler (1995) is a visual artist and illustrator who lives and works in Stuttgart, Germany. He studied at the State Academy of Art and Design in Stuttgart and graduated in 2022 with a diploma in communication design. His works range from illustration to print graphics and have been shown in national and international exhibitions. Inspired by graffiti culture, the artist spontaneously creates abstract, colorful compositions that originate in his sketchbooks and playfully deal with the degree of abstraction.

"SPRING" BY KLEOPATRA MOURSELA


